#### 2024 Benefit Highlights How does HMO-POS work for providers?

In the Gold Kidney HMO-POS Plans, member copayments and coinsurance remain consistent, whether the healthcare service is obtained from an in-network or out-of-network provider. Members do not incur any additional costs or penalties for receiving care from a provider who is not part of the network.

- Member Copayments and Coinsurance Whether the healthcare service is provided by an innetwork or out-of-network provider, the member's copayment or coinsurance may be collected at the time of service.
- In-Network / Contracted Providers In-network providers can offer care to members and submit claims to Gold Kidney Health Plan for reimbursement.
- Out-of-Network / Non-Contracted Providers Out-of-network providers are also permitted to deliver care to Gold Kidney members and submit claims for reimbursement. Gold Kidney will reimburse the out-of-network provider at 100% of the applicable Medicare allowable, following Medicare payment rules, minus any applicable copays or coinsurance.

#### It's not too late to get your Flu Shot!



Providers, as the first line of defense for all sick patients, let's prioritize our health and the wellbeing of those around us this winter season by getting our flu

shots. Remind patients of the crucial importance of receiving the flu vaccine to prevent the spread of the flu. Together, we can contribute to a healthier community.

#### **Information For Health Professionals**

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends yearly flu vaccines for persons 6 months and older without vaccine contraindication. Providers may administer any U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved, age-appropriate flu vaccine. Review the current <u>flu vaccine product table</u> for the most recent updates on product availability and their approved age ranges.

# What flu vaccines are recommended this season?

For this flu season, providers may choose to administer any licensed, age-appropriate flu vaccine (IIV, RIV4, or LAIV4). ACIP Recommendations

#### Vaccine options this season include:

- Standard dose flu vaccines.
- <u>High-dose vaccines</u> for people 65 years and older.
- <u>Vaccines made with adjuvant</u> for people
   65 years and older.
- Vaccines made with virus grown in cell <u>culture</u>. No eggs are involved in the production of this vaccine.

## Important notes for this flu season<sup>1</sup>

- The <u>composition of flu vaccines</u> has been updated.
- The influenza A(H1N1) pdm09 vaccine virus component was updated for eggbased and cell- or recombinant-based flu vaccines.
- All flu vaccines will be quadrivalent (four component), meaning designed to protect against four different flu viruses. For more information: <u>Quadrivalent Influenza</u> <u>Vaccine | CDC</u>.

#### Recommendations this Flu Season<sup>1</sup>

- Routine annual influenza vaccination is recommended for all persons aged 6 months and older who do not have contraindications.
- For most persons who need only one dose of influenza vaccine for the season, vaccination should ideally be offered during September or October.

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- However, vaccination should continue throughout the season as long as influenza viruses are circulating.
- Approved dose volumes vary by age and product. An age-appropriate vaccine should be used at an appropriate dose.
- Persons who are pregnant or who might be pregnant during the influenza season should receive influenza vaccine.

#### **Coding Considerations**

- Please file claims with correct coding\*
- The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) <u>coding chart</u> recommends which billing code to use based on the vaccine administered. (This chart is not a comprehensive list.)
- Code descriptions are specific to the vaccine product.
- Code descriptions may include:

- Dosage amounts
- Distinctive features (i.e., preservative-free, split virus, recombinant DNA, cell cultures or adjuvanted)
- \* Correct coding requires services to be reported with the most specific code available that appropriately describes the service

Please ensure any vaccines that are administered are entered into the ASIIS-Arizona Department of Health Services
